### Information Technology and Systems Improvement Committee Minutes February 25, 2021

A public meeting of the Information Technology and Systems Improvement Committee of the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission was convened on Thursday, February 25, 2021, at the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission Office, 1110 W. Washington, Suite 230, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

### I. Call to Order and Roll Call

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson David Byers at 1:33pm p.m. The roll was taken, and a quorum was declared present.

### II. Minutes of the Wednesday, September 15, 2020 Meeting

Chairperson Byers called for any changes to the minutes. Sheila Polk made a motion to approve the minutes of the meeting held on September 15, 2020. The minutes were unanimously approved by the Committee.

### III. Full-Service Forensic Crime Laboratory Grant Program

Marc Peoples provided an overview of the Full-Service Forensic Crime Laboratory Grant Program. The FY22 funding recommendation for a grant allocation in the amount of \$500,000 was presented. The committee discussed the future of Full Service Allocations and rethinking the distribution formula due to decline revenues. Chairperson Byers called for any objections or corrections to the allocation. Steven Stahl made a motion to approve the FY21 grant allocation in the amount of \$500,000. The motion was seconded by Tim Chung and was unanimously approved by the Committee.

### **IV.** Update on Current CJ Systems Improvement Project

### A. Orders of Protection

Marc Peoples, Criminal Justice Systems Improvement Program Manager, provided a status update on the Order of Protection and Injunction against Harassment (OP/IAH) project. ACJC has proposed legislation to restore holder record responsibility to the Sheriffs. Future meetings have been scheduled to determine how the Sheriffs will be included in the work flow in AZ Point improvements. Marc People presents the complete servicing portal.

### **B. E-Warrants**

Marc Peoples provided an update on the progress of the E-warrant project. Currently Eight law enforcement agencies have implemented and are operational on JWI.

AJACS Courts in Prescott (Muni and Justice), Williams Justice, Flagstaff Justice, and Mohave Superior Court are operational.

### C. Conditions of Release

Marc Peoples provided an update on the Conditions of Release project. Since the last meeting, the project has been significantly delayed due to COVID. Given the delay, ACJC has decided to notify the BJA of its inability to complete the Conditions of Release project at this time.

### D. Arizona Disposition Reporting System (ADRS)

Shayla Gilleland, Criminal Justice Systems Improvement Program Project Manager provided a status update ADRS. The ADRS project continues to progress with 5 county attorney's offices currently submitting electronic dispositions to DPS. This includes Coconino County, Greenlee County, Maricopa County Attorney, Navajo County Attorney and Pinal County Prosecutor. The remaining 10 county attorney's offices are in various phases (e.g., testing, implementation, etc.).

### **E. Victim Notification System**

Marc Peoples provided an update on the Conditions of Release project.

ACJC received an OVC grant to implement a new statewide Victim Notification System with the jails and the Department of Corrections. Marc has spoken with all of the Sheriff Departments and currently has 13 ready to start the project. Currently, ACJC is in the last phase of getting a contract signed. The Policy Team will convene at a later date to discuss logistics and resource. A Governor's committee will be developed at that time.

### F. Mobile Fingerprinting

Marc Peoples provided an update on the progress of the 2FID project. The following counties have opted in for 2FID device implementations managed by the AOC: Apache, Cochise, Coconino, Gila, Graham, Greenlee, La Paz, Mohave, Navajo, Pinal, Santa Cruz, Yavapai, Yuma, and Maricopa. Programming for Phase II of the project has been completed. Working with Mohave to start piloting next month.

### V. Technical Team

Marc People informed the committee that the Technical Team has been reestablished to support the strategic plans, business goals and objectives, established by the Policy Team. ACJC is still recruiting members to ensure statewide representation. The First meeting will convene February 24, 2021.

### VI. ACJC Legislative Update

Andrew Leferve provide update on ACJC legislative actions.

### VII. Call to the Public

Chairperson Byers made a call to the public. No members of the public addressed the Policy Team.
