The Water Infrastructure Finance Authority of Arizona (WIFA) is an independent state authority authorized to finance the construction, rehabilitation, acquisition, and improvement of water infrastructure throughout Arizona. WIFA is governed by its board consisting of nine voting members appointed by the governor and legislative leadership and nine nonvoting ex-officio members representing legislative leadership and relevant agency heads. The Authority administers several federal and state-capitalized programs, the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund, the Clean Water State Revolving Fund, the Water Supply Development Fund, the Water Conservation Grant Fund, and the Long-Term Water Augmentation Fund. Through these programs, WIFA protects current and future residents, the economy, and the environment of this state by funding projects that protect water quality, ensure reliability and access to safe drinking water, conserve water, improve the efficiency and reuse of existing water resources, and augment existing water resources with new renewable supplies of water.
