26. JUSTIFICATION OF REQUEST

BNSF railroad crossings at 27th Avenue and Thomas Road (DOT 025-430G and 025-617C) in Phoenix, are on the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) list of crossings with the most incidents in the U.S. in the last decade. Thomas Road is listed at number one and 27th Avenue is number five. The Arizona Corporation Commission (ACC) is requiring additional railroad signal warning safety equipment at these crossings that was not in the original plans. Additional funding is necessary due to a change in scope of work that necessitates road widening. There is additional design, revisions, coordination, and meetings. Utility coordination and relocation are part of the 01D phase. Railroad costs include design of the signal equipment and preemption, railroad engineering reviews, and a railroad PE agreement for consultant representation. In addition, the FHWA cost split has changed to 90/10 percent.




