House Bill 2862, Section 96 (55<sup>th</sup> Legislature, 2<sup>nd</sup> Regular Session (AZ 2022)) provided \$6 million for cities and towns who provide water to citizens in Apache and Navajo Counties and \$4 million for irrigation districts in Cochise and Graham Counties, to contract with outside advisors, attorneys, consultants, and aides that are reasonably necessary or desirable to enable the cities, towns, and districts to adequately perform their duties. The WIFA has received from the City of Winslow, Town of Taylor, Town of Snowflake, City of Holbrook, City of Show Low, City of St. Johns, Town of Eagar, Town of Springerville, Gila Valley Irrigation District, Markham Irrigation District, and St. David Irrigation District requests for Water Projects Assistance Grants.
