NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING OF THE ARIZONA STATE BOARD OF DENTAL EXAMINERS’ INVESTIGATIVE COMMITTEE

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statute (“A.R.S”) § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the Arizona State Board of Dental Examiners’ (“Board”) **Investigative Committee** (“Committee”) and to the general public that the Committee will hold a meeting open to the public on **Tuesday, August 22, 2023 at 1:00 p.m.** The meeting will be held in virtual and telephonic formats. Members of the public may also participate virtually or telephonically. After the start of the meeting, the Committee chairperson and/or staff will request that members of the public place their phones/devices on mute.

The meeting is open to the public. However, during the course of the meeting, the Committee, upon a majority vote of a quorum of the members, may, when necessary, hold an executive session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(2) and/or (3) as indicated on the Committee’s Agenda. The executive session is not open to the public.

Information concerning the Committee’s Agenda, including a copy of the Agenda and any amendments, can be obtained at the Board’s office, through the Board’s website at www.dentalboard.az.gov or by calling the Board’s office at 602-241-1492 The Committee Agenda is subject to change up to 24 hours prior to the meeting. Agenda items are noted by number and letter for convenience and reference. The Committee may address the agenda items in any order within the time frame, if any, indicated and may set over matters to a later time when necessary. The Committee reserves the right to change the order of the agenda items, except for matters set for a specific time.
