Pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the Arizona Board of Executive Clemency and to the general public that the **Arizona Board of Executive Clemency** is meeting for the purpose of conducting a hearing on **Thursday, November 3, 2022 at 9:00 a.m.** at the **Arizona Board of Executive Clemency Office, 4000 N Central Ave, Suite 2300, Phoenix, Arizona 85012<sup>1</sup>**. This hearing is open to the public but will have limited capacity. In person attendance will be on a first come basis, therefore, virtual attendance is strongly encouraged. The Board may vote to go into Executive Session, which will not be open to the public, to discuss any matter on this agenda pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03 (A) (3) (Discussion or consultation with Board attorney for legal advice). The Board may go into Executive Session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03 (A) (2) for discussion or consideration of records exempt by law from public inspection, including the receipt and discussion of information or testimony that is specifically required to be maintained as confidential by state or federal law.

#### **Reprieve/Commutation of Sentence hearing regarding Murray Hooper, ADCRR # 047621**

*Description:* In 1983, Murray Hooper, ADCRR# 047621, was convicted in Maricopa County Superior Court Case CR-121686 of First-Degree Murder, and was sentenced to death. The Arizona Supreme Court issued a Warrant of Execution on October 12, 2022. An execution date has been scheduled for November 16, 2022. At the Reprieve/Commutation of Sentence hearing, the Board of Executive Clemency may receive information to consider, discuss, and vote on whether to recommend a Commutation of Sentence and/or a Reprieve to the Governor.
