Action to be Ratified:

The Independent Redistricting Commission ("Commission") seeks to ratify an action taken at its January 21, 2021, meeting. Specifically, there was a technical difficulty concerning the streaming service utilized to provide public access to the meeting, and during this period of a technical difficulty, the Commission voted on and approved the public session and executive session minutes for the Commission's January 14, 2021, meeting (Item II on the January 14, 2021, agenda).
