- 5) The Board may discuss and take action to adjust the depreciation calculation sheet to include values for a calf in womb, registered calves and cows and horses depredated by Mexican wolves.
- 6) The Board may discuss and take action to review and approve an amendment to its Wolf Depredation Policy by expanding the list of livestock covered.
- 7) The Board may discuss and take action to approve depredation prevention grant(s) applications.
- 8) The Board may discuss and take action to approve depredation claim(s) for the loss of Arizona livestock from confirmed Mexican wolf depredations(s).
- 9) Executive Session (The Board will not vote to take any action during the Executive Session). The Board may vote to meet in the Executive Session in accordance with A.R.S. 38-431.03(A)(3) for the purpose of discussing and consulting with legal counsel for legal advice.
- 10) Adjournment.
