The Commission may vote to go into Executive Session, which will not be open to the public, to discuss matters pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03 (A)(1), (3) and (5) regarding Employee Issues, APA EE Handbook/Reimbursement Policy, a Power Pooling Program and discussion or consultation for legal advice with the attorneys of the Authority regarding the same.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431(4), arrangements for electronic, video, or internet participation by one or more Commission members may be required to facilitate a quorum and act on agenda items.
